

Supplemental Educational Services

During the 2009-10 school year, Elmwood Place Elementary met Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) and has been designated with an “Excellent” rating by the Ohio Department of Education. However, the school must meet AYP again this year to be out of “School Improvement” status. Therefore, Elmwood Place continues to offer Parent School Choice (PSC) and Supplemental Educational Services (SES). SES is academic enrichment/tutoring provided by state approved educational agencies. Tutoring is paid for by the district with Title I funds or district funds. SES services are provided outside the school day at locations determined by the service providers. The district does not provide transportation.

A complete list of state-approved Providers (and details about qualifications, curriculum, ability to serve English Language Learners, and students with disabilities is available through the Ohio Department of Education (ODE) website or directly at ODE’s: Supplemental List of Service Providers.

Information on SES providers is available in a binder in the Elmwood Place Elementary office. The per-pupil amount (PPA) for Elmwood Place Elementary eligible students is set by the Ohio Department of Education. This year the PPA is \$1,384.85.

In August and again in September all Elmwood Place Elementary students were made aware of the SES options. Enrollment is open through September 30, and again in November.

During the 2009-10 school year, one (1) student chose PSC, and seven (7) students took advantage of SES.
